3. The number of shares (or cash equivalents) will be adjusted based on certain performance criteria, including criteria other than the market price, as specified under the Company LTIP.

4. Not applicable.

5. The Performance Units, granted in 2021, will vest on 12/31/23 and will be settled in 2024 when they are determined and awarded by the MD&C Committee.

6. The Performance Units, granted in 2022, will vest on 12/31/24 and will be settled in 2025 when they are determined and awarded by the MD&C Committee.

7. Each Time-Based Restricted Stock Unit represents a contingent right to receive one share of Company common stock.

8. The Time-Based Restricted Stock Units, granted in 2022 under the LTIP, will vest 100% on 12/31/24.
